

Kamiah, a small city on the beautiful Clearwater River got its name from the NezPerce word for the place of "many rope litters", as it was the place where the NezPerce Indians made their ropes for fishing on the river. Lewis and Clark arrived in the Kamiah Valley in 1806 on their way to the Pacific Ocean. They found the NezPerce people most friendly and helpful. Presbyterian missionaries arrived in 1871 and organized the first Presbyterian Church. White families began to arrive in the early 1890's. Stores were erected shortly after the railroad was built

across the river in 1899. The town site at that time was near the railroad depot on leased land. Near the end of the five year lease, several businessmen decided to find a more permanent site and bought land where the present town stands. Dr. Bridwell was most instrumental in the organizing and building the town of Kamiah. The buildings that housed his drugstore and his home are still in use and are on the Idaho Historical Register. Main Street is much the same size that it has been for the last 100 years, and some of the buildings that were built in the first ten years of the town burned and were rebuilt in 1910, are still standing and in use. In 1990 Kamiah adopted the Western/Victorian theme, and the businesses and stores re-modeled the fronts of their establishments to carry out the theme. The Kamiah IOOF Lodge was organized and built in 1901. The building stood until 2006, when it was replaced by the present fire/police complex. The Masonic Lodge was organized in 1913, and their building is still in use. The Kamiah Hotel was built in 1910, and is in use now as a bar and restaurant. The American Legion was organized in 1920, with their building dedicated in 1948, which is being used for many community events. The Kamiah Chamber is very active, as is the newly organized Kamiah Historical Society Museum, which are housed side by side on Main Street.
